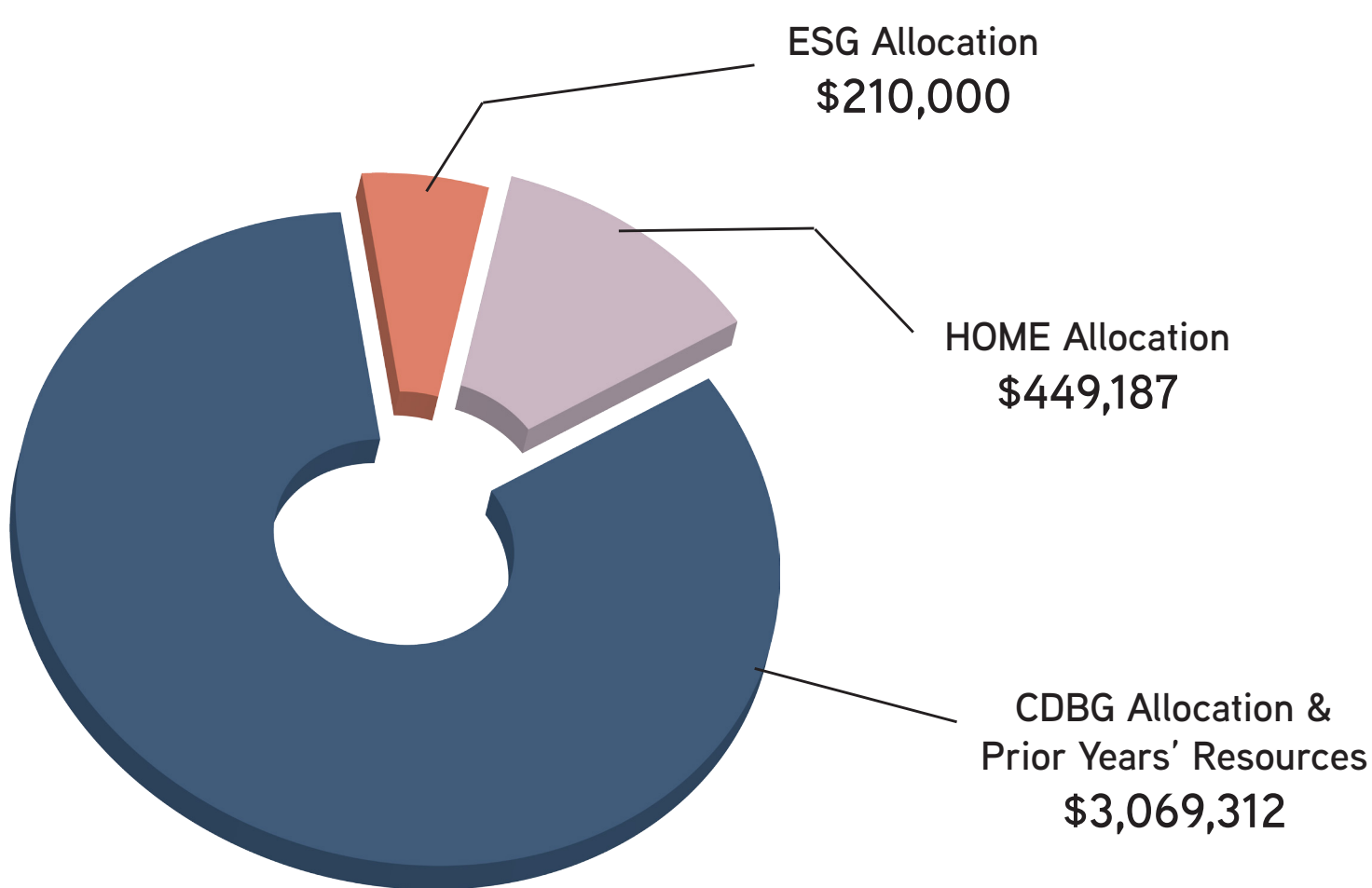


2017 CITY OF CANTON ACTION PLAN

Program Period from April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018

The City of Canton is the administrative authority of three Federal entitlement grants: the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the HOME Investment Partnership allocation and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). The funds provide community development services to City of Canton residents.
