FY 2016 CDBG & HOME Grants

The City of Canton has set aside up to \$2 million in CDBG and up to \$200,000 in HOME funds for this RFP.

At the discretion of the City, these funds may be awarded to various activities under the RFP or set aside for other activities not covered by the RFP.
