Dear Mayor Healy,

The University of Toledo would like to thank you for the opportunity to work with you and your staff to help the students of Canton pursue their goals of higher education. We have recently reviewed our scholarship program and are in the process of making a number of changes. One that will directly affect you and your students is that we will no longer be offering a special scholarship for students coming from the Canton area for the 2013-14 school year. Instead, we are introducing a new Scholarship Grid that will make understanding how to earn a scholarship at The University of Toledo easier than ever.

The enclosed Scholarship Grid for the 2013-14 school year shows how a student with a 3.25 GPA and 20 ACT score could earn \$3,500 per year in scholarships. A student with a 3.75 GPA and 22 ACT could even earn \$6,500 per year! This is considerably more money than what we have offered students in the past. We want to assure you of our commitment to the education of Canton students so if you would like to update your website with the enclosed Scholarship Grid, please feel free to do so.

We also have a number of additional scholarships for which students may apply. These additional scholarships often require letters of reference, which we would be more than happy to accept from your office.
