Miami University is excited about entering into a partnership with the Mayor's Scholarship Program for the 2011-2012 academic year. Miami will offer an unlimited number of \$2500 annual scholarships (\$10,000 over four years) for students who are admitted to the Oxford campus and meet the other program eligibility requirements as outlined on your web site. We understand that to be eligible, students must graduate from one of the Canton public schools and be a resident of the city of Canton.

The scholarship is renewable for a total of eight semesters of study at Miami as long as the student maintains a cumulative GPA of 2.5 and maintains satisfactory academic progress. This award will be in addition to any other merit scholarship assistance a student receives (up to Miami's published Cost of Attendance).

Due to the nature of our admission process and our academic schedule, students must have submitted their letter of approval from your office to us by January 31st. Letters can be sent to the Office of Admission. Per our discussion, your office will also provide us a list of all Mayor's Scholarship Program students by March 1st each year.

This is an exciting partnership that we look forward to continuing well into the future.
