The Department of Community Development, on behalf of the City of Canton, is requesting proposals for the 2020 HOME grant program (HOME), 2020 Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG), 2020 Emergency Solutions Grant program (ESG), and for the 2020 Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Areas (NRSA).

### Timeline:

- ✚ Accepting applications – **Beginning Monday, December 23, 2019 at midnight**
- ✚ Submission Deadline – **Tuesday, January 21, 2020 at midnight**
- ✚ Program year - will begin **April 1, 2020** pending the allocation of federal funds.

**ESG is paper application only.** The location to obtain application forms and to submit 4 sealed applications:


