- 3. Photographer's name and photo title should not appear on front of image or mounting board.
- 4. Up to two (2) photo entries per photographer will be accepted. New entries only, no previous entries accepted.
- 5. Entries must be received by mail, or dropped off to: "Arbor Day Photo Contest", City of Canton Engineering Department, 2436 30th St. NE, Canton, OH 44705, before 4:00 PM on **Entry Deadline: Thursday, April 16, 2020.**
- 6. Entries will be displayed for public viewing and voting during the City of Canton's 7th Annual Arbor Day Celebration at the Canton Garden Center in Stadium Park, on Friday, April 24, 2020, between the hours of 11:00 AM 2:00 PM.
- 7. Entries will also be exhibited for public viewing at The Joseph Saxton Gallery of Photography, 520 Cleveland Ave. NW, Canton, Ohio 44702, during First Friday, May 1, 2020, from 6:00 10:00 PM. Winners will be announced at 7:00 PM.
- 8. Prizes: 1st Place = \$150; 2nd Place = \$100; 3rd Place = \$50; and 4 Honorable Mentions = \$25 each; will be awarded at The Joseph Saxton Gallery of Photography on First Friday, May 1, 2020; or may be picked up at City of Canton Engineering Department, 2436 30th St. NE, Canton, during regular business hours, after Friday, May 15, 2020.
