




Discharge/release/spill of illicit substance or debris



[RESPONDING DEPARTMENT] responsibilities:

Coordinate as necessary with secondary responders to identify, contain, trace the source of, and eliminate the discharge.
 For drinking water contamination concerns, call CITY WATER DEPARTMENT immediately at 330-489-3315.



1 City MS4 ("Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System") = Any City-owned/operated storm drainage system such as storm sewers, catch basins, roadside ditches/swales, culverts, detention/retention basins, etc. within City right-of-way/easement or on City property. "City MS4" does NOT include private storm drainage systems, drainage systems owned/operated by a township, Stark County, or another city, "waters of the state", or sanitary sewer systems.

2 "water of the state" = Natural water bodies such as creeks, lakes, streams, ponds, wetlands, swamps, etc. that are not owned, maintained, or operated by the City.

3 "private drainage system" = Any storm drainage system including storm sewers, catch basins, roadside ditches/swales, culverts, detention/retention basins, etc. that is NOT owned/maintained/operated by the City or another government jurisdiction.
