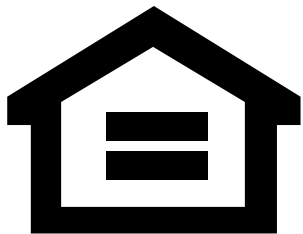

AMENDED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

- ▶ The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires jurisdictions to consult with individuals and agencies within the jurisdiction that will be affected by HUD funds.
- ▶ The Citizen Participation Plan defines how the City will conduct these consultations. Public hearings are part of the consultation process.
- ▶ **This will likely be the last virtual hearing for Canton if COVID-19 cases continue to decline.**

AMENDED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

- ▶ Federal Regulations at 24 CFR 91.505 (a) require that a plan be amended with any the following occur:
 - ▶ To make a change in its allocation priorities or a change in the method of distribution of funds;
 - ▶ To carry out an activity, using funds from any program covered by the consolidated plan (including program income, reimbursements, repayment, recaptures, or reallocations from HUD), not previously described in the action plan; or
 - ▶ To change the purpose, scope, location, or beneficiaries of an activity.

AMENDED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

- ▶ 24 CFR 91.505 (b) states that “The jurisdiction shall identify in its citizen participation plan the criteria it will use for determining what constitutes a substantial amendment. It is these substantial amendments that are subject to a citizen participation process, in accordance with the jurisdiction's citizen participation plan.”

The Citizen Participation process includes advertising the changes, allowing a 30-day comment period, and holding at least one public hearing when the Action Plan is released or an amendment is made.

AMENDED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

- ▶ The City's Citizen Participation Plan previously approved by HUD allowed the City to make changes within categories or "projects" as long as the entire project budget did not increase or decrease by 50% or more.
- ▶ One project can have numerous "activities".
 - ▶ Under the existing plan, activities could be added or deleted as long as the budget for the project did not change by more than 50%.

AMENDED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

- ▶ Under the new amendment to the Citizen Participation Plan, the following will be considered substantial amendments.
 - ▶ To make a change in its allocation priorities or a change in the method of distribution of funds;
 - ▶ To carry out an activity, using funds from any program covered by the consolidated plan (including program income, reimbursements, repayment, recaptures, or reallocations from HUD), not previously described in the action plan;
 - ▶ To remove an activity that is not moving forward; or
 - ▶ To change the purpose, scope, location, or beneficiaries of an activity.

AMENDED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

- ▶ In addition amendments that are not substantial, or Minor Amendments include the following
 - ▶ Changes of a 50% increase or decrease in the funding of an activity necessary for preserving all the programs and activities identified in a Plan,
 - ▶ Correction of typographical errors in the original plan, or
 - ▶ Changes in contact information.
- ▶ Minor amendments require the approval of the Community Development Director or their designated representative.

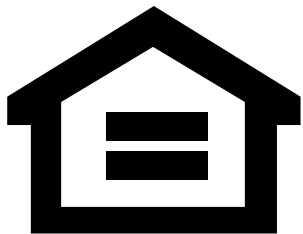
