


The City of Canton Department of Development collaborated with local non-profit housing partners to address affordable housing needs of the community. Between 2016 and 2018, the City allocated \$3.16 million of federal community development and housing funds towards the production of multiple and single family housing units and neighborhood improvements leveraging \$6.72 million dollars of other funds.
