2018 SUMMER EMPLOYMENT AND CAMP PROGRAMS



The City of Canton Department of Development will partner with private companies and local non-profits to invest over \$500,000 of federal funds to provide free summer employment and summer camp opportunities to Canton's youth. The program will provide opportunities to over 500 low-moderate income youth, ages 5 through 18.



Summer employment programs offer youth a paycheck, along with valuable employment experiences and other organized activities. Summer employment programs also work to achieve a set of goals; increasing participants' income, developing professional skills, expanding personal networks to improve labor market prospects, and offering constructive activities to promote positive behavior. On average, summer programs are active between seven and nine weeks.



Summer camp programs provide kids and teens with an active and adventurous summer. The camp programs offer youth fun and unique experiences in safe, structured, and properly supervised environments. The academic enrichment programs will include tutoring and mentoring services. The employment programs provide opportunities to build the capacity of our local knowledge based workforce.
