**WHEREAS,** Malone College was founded in 1892 as the Cleveland Bible College by Walter and Emma Malone. In 1957, it was relocated to Canton, Ohio, and in 2008, the private, liberal arts school became a university. January 1, 2012, marked the beginning of the official term of David A. King, Ed.D. as the thirteenth president of Malone University; and

**WHEREAS,** Dr. David King came to Malone from Eastern University (PA) where he served since 1991, most recently as provost. Prior to that position, he served as executive dean and chief development officer for Campolo College of Graduate & Professional Studies, as vice president for administration and director of human resources. He also served on numerous academic committees, and is the recipient of Honorary Life Membership, Distinguished Service Award, Diedrich K. Willers Award, and Excellence in Human Resources Practice Award by CUPA-HR; and

**WHEREAS,** Dr. David King received a B.S. in social work from Eastern Mennonite University, M.S. degrees in human services administration and human resources development from Villanova University, an education management certificate from Institute for Education Management, Harvard University Graduate School of Education, and the Ed.D. in higher education administration from Temple University; and

**WHEREAS,** Dr. David King is married to Winnie Lowrie King, and together they have two adult children, Lindsey King Wilby and Justin, and are proud grandparents of James, their two-year-old grandson; and
