**RECOGNIZING THE CANTON NEGRO OLDTIMERS, INC.
CLASS OF 2012 ENSHRINEE
ROBERT C. REDVINE**

WHEREAS, the Canton Negro Oldtimers, Inc. is celebrating over 50 years of community service and holding a banquet and induction ceremony recognizing Robert Redvine for his athletic achievements in football, baseball, and basketball; and

WHEREAS, in 1953, Redvine was an All City Basketball Player for Emmon School averaging 20 shots a game. In the following two years he was an All City Basketball Player at Lorin Andrews, averaging 24 shots a game. He was also an All City Player in basketball and an All City runner in track; and

WHEREAS, in the 60's and early 70's, he played on the city league in Massillon where he averaged 22 shots a game. In 2001, he was inducted into the Greater Canton slow pitch Hall of fame for his success in baseball, played City League Baseball in Massillon with a batting average of .450, and was also named an All Star for three years in Massillon's C League; and

WHEREAS, along with many other achievements, Robert has dedicated years to coaching baseball, basketball and football. He has been a two-time Champion in football, won four Championships in baseball, and three Championships in basketball. He is currently playing in the Akron Silver League and has been named All Star as well as the 2007 Champions; and
