RECOGNIZING WILLIAM BUELL STARK COUNTY SWIMMING AND DIVING HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

WHEREAS, it is with the greatest honor that the Stark County Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame will recognize William Buell as a 2014 Hall of Fame Inductee presented by the Greater Canton Aquatics Association; and

WHEREAS, William began swimming at the age of five, quickly realizing his love for the sport. Throughout his high school career William held 29 school records including the pool record at Washington High School for the 50 yard freestyle. As a result of his dedication and hard work he earned a trip to the State Championships two years in a row; and

WHEREAS, in 1994 William swam for the Lake Erie Zone with his relay team finishing first with a time of 1:39:03 long course, the Zone national record; and

WHEREAS, William received a scholarship to attend West Virginia Wesleyan in 1995, and in the same year was an eight time All-American in numerous swimming events. He graduated in 2000 with his BS in Financial Planning from The Ohio State University, and currently resides in North Canton with his wife Sarah.
