FILING OF APPLICATION

Application must be made on the regular application form available in the office of the Canton Civil Service Commission, Canton City Hall, Third Floor, 218 Cleveland Avenue SW, Canton, OH 44702.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING & EXPERIENCE

All candidates must have graduated from an accredited college or university with at least a baccalaureate degree, including at least forty-five quarter units or thirty semester units of science courses approved by the Ohio Board of Sanitarian Registration; be a registered sanitarian-in-training, or be eligible for sanitarian registration by the Ohio Board of Sanitarian Registration; and have a valid driver's license.

A transcript of college grades must be submitted with the application.

CANDIDATE EVALUATION

Candidates will be evaluated on education and work experience.

EDUCATION

Applicants meeting the minimum requirements will be assigned a initial basic score of 70%. Applicants possessing a degree in Environmental Health or a Registered Sanitarian will be assigned an initial basic score of 80%. Applicants who possess a degree in Environmental Health and are a Registered Sanitarian will be assigned an initial basic score of 90%.

In addition to the basic score, one point will be added for each semester hour (1.5 quarter hours) for course work in the areas of environmental health, air pollution, wastewater, water supply, solid waste, hazardous materials, biostatistics and epidemiology.

WORK EXPERIENCE

Two (2) points will be added to the basic score for each complete year of work experience with a local, state or federal agency as sanitarian or equivalent. The maximum score attainable is 100% prior to award of bonus points for Honorably Discharged Veterans.

ELIGIBLE FOR EMPLOYMENT

Applicants name will be placed on an eligible list for two (2) years. Ranking will be based on total score. Rank is subject to change due to the addition or withdrawal of candidates. When a position is to be filled, the three highest ranking individuals who are interested in employment will be certified to the Canton Health Department for final selection.

VETERAN BONUS

Applicants who are Honorable Discharged Veterans having served more than 180 consecutive days on active duty and present their DD-214 Form long version **AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION** will receive 20% additional credit, provided they make a passing score.

EQUAL EMPLOYMENT

All qualified applicants will receive consideration for appointment without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex, political affiliation, age, type of disability, or any other non-merit factor.

DUTIES

Performs inspections, field sampling and testing, engages in information activities and engages in enforcement under the close direction of the Director of Environmental Health, Administrator, or a sanitarian of a higher classification.
