

Beginning with the 2010-11 academic year, Bowling Green State University and the City of Canton Mayor's Office hereby enter into a cooperative scholarship program.

• Canton Mayor's Scholarship Program

- Must be a resident within the Canton City Limits and attend a public school for a full year prior to application
- Must Complete letter of inquiry to Mayor's Office and receive a letter of recommendation from the Mayor's Office
- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Must be a full-time student pursuing first bachelor's degree
- Must be admitted as a unconditional regular admit student to BGSU
- Must be full-time and maintain full-time status, standard semesters, at BGSU, BG Campus and maintain a 2.75 cumulative G.P.A. while enrolled at BGSU
 - Complete terms and conditions of the Scholarship will be provided to each student
- Students with minimum 3.25 cumulative high school G.P.A. will be **guaranteed** to receive the BGSU minimum academic scholarship worth a grand total of \$6,000 over the course of 4-years (\$1,500 per year; terms and conditions apply).
- Other awards (based on GPA and test scores) available at \$3,000 and \$5,000 annually
- BGSU will work with the Canton students to identify other potential forms of aid, *some as high as full tuition and fees*. These may include the University Tuition Scholarship for Historically Underrepresented Students, the Ribeau President's Leadership Academy, and the Academic Investment in Math & Science Programs.
