APRIL, 2006

The Canton Board of Park Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, April 5, 2006, at the Garden Center Building.

The meeting was called to order by President Black at 4:05 p.m.

At this time a motion was made by A. Black to approve the minutes of the March 1, 2006 regular meeting as written. A second was made by S. Lamiell, and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Use Requests:


OTHER BUSINESS:

1. Use Requests:


- A. Canton Negro Oldtimers requesting the use of Nimisilla Park on June 24, 2006, to hold their annual Handicap and Senior Citizens Community Picnic and on August 13, 2006 to sponsor the Green County Social Club Picnic.
- B. Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation requesting to use Stadium and Monument Parks on September 9, 2006, to hold their annual "Walk to Cure Diabetes."
- C. Kingdom Work Enterprise (Tribe of Judah School of Strings) requesting to use Westbrook Veterans Memorial Park on July 29, 2006, to hold a public communal baptism ceremony.

The Board reviewed these requests, and a motion was made by A. Black to approve them with insurance requirements, but use C would not be able to use the pond for baptism due to concerns with water quality and the Park System's long standing rule against swimming or wading. A second was made by S. Lamiell, and the motion passed by unanimous vote.
